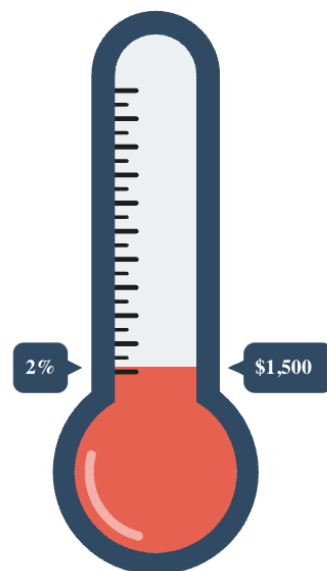

Iceland is thinking about dropping a digit from our currency. Currently the conversion is 1 USD to 139 ISK. This change would reduce that to a 1 to 13.9 exchange. While prices would still remain the same value, the number associated with that cost would be reduced. As seen with the van, the cost currently is over 10 million ISK, with this change, it would be just over 1 million.
