Our first day of use allowed us to transport nearly thirty people to and from church! What an opportunity! Because of your sacrificial giving and prayers, God is able to reach into the lives of these people. We have already seen an increase in attendance of our Sunday afternoon services. While we are absolutely excited for the opportunity to present the gospel to more and more souls, it does also increase the funds needed to sustain this ministry. We are greatful to have such a strong base of supporters who believe in the mission that God has called us to.

The Road Ahead

With all that God has already done in just the first month of the year, we are ecstatic to see what God does in the coming months. We have plans to continue my Icelandic language education and use of the van to bring lost souls to Christ, but we know that God often has plans that we do not know about until they are already completed, and we are very eager to watch Him work.

Hidden Blessings

There are often things in ministry that no one tells you about, that no one is going to brag about but are often a large part of your service to God. For instance, no missionary is going to put in their prayer letter the coutless hours they spent mopping the floor and taking out the trash, however, in some cases, these things take an enormous amount of time. This month, I had the tremendous opportunity to clean up human excrement from our church's lawn. There is (and has been for a long time) a disdain for those who truly love God and do His work here in Iceland.
