# In the Rear View Mirror

As you may remember from February's prayer letter, we kicked off this month with a teen activity and a baptism of one of our Icelandic adults. On that same Sunday, my wife, our son, and I were able to sing a special with Everett's very first solo. We sang the song "If Jesus Said it I Believe It" which is a beautiful song about God's perfect wisdom as we go through the trials of life. During Pastor Weimer's absence, I have had the tremendous opportunity to teach the oldest group of children during our Icelandic outreach services. For thirty minutes each week I am able to teach their memory verse. It has been such an amazing opportunity to be able to take a single verse and explain its meaning and significance in their own language. The first week's verse was Romans 6:23. It was such a blessing to watch the light bulbs turn on in their heads as I explained what this verse means. I am so thankful for the Icelandic language classes I have been able to complete as I can see just how much I have learned from them. Please pray for me as I teach these young children about the truths of Scripture. My wife has also been designated as the teacher for the first and second grade class. We are both loving the opportunity to teach the next generation about the things of Christ.

## The Road Ahead

As we quickly approach Easter, our church will be holding a special Passover celebration. We will meet at the church every day of the week leading up to Easter and will be walking through the events of the week leading up to Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection, and what they represent from the Old Testament. We are very excited about what God is going to do through this celebration. Please pray that it is used by God to teach our church people more about the gospel. We are also talking with several individuals in our church who have expressed a desire to be baptized, and we are eager to see them follow through in believer's baptism. There has been no damage done yet, but please pray that no matter what happens, our church is able to be a beacon of hope and peace to our community.
