In the Rear View Mirror

We are so glad to be back home in Iceland! After landing in the U.S. on July 4th, we were able to attend the funeral for J.C. Wright, Megumi's grandfather. We were then able to spend some amazing time with Megumi's parents there in Asheville, NC, and visit our sending church and my parents in Charleston, SC. While there, my brother and sister were also able to make the trip to Charleston. We had such a great time together as a family during this very unexpected visit. During our stay in Charleston, our sending church, Coastal Light Baptist Church, hosted a revival conference with a guest speaker, S.A. Scott. Though it was not the intended purpose for this trip back to the States, God used this revival meeting as a fantastic time of encouragement and challenge to our hearts. Directly following this revival meeting, we traveled back up to Asheville, where we would spend our last few days with Megumi's parents before we flew back to Iceland. On our last Sunday, I was asked to preach at two different churches. I thoroughly enjoyed this opportunity.

The Road Ahead

Two days after arriving in Iceland, William and Phyllis Weimer, our pastor's son and daughter-in-law, flew to the U.S. to raise funds for their missionary work here. Their absence will leave us short-staffed, as they speak Icelandic and teach in our Sunday services. Losing them for three months will leave a significant void for our volunteer staff. Please pray for their safety and swift support so they can return to Iceland in God's timing. Please also pray for our church in their absence as we continue to minister to this nation. You may remember in our last prayer letter that I mentioned a man named Destiny who trusted Christ as his Savior. During our trip to America, I learned that he had been removed from Iceland and sent to Lyon, France. I am working to find a church or missionary that would be able to reach out to him. Please pray that we would be able to find a way to disciple him and teach him the importance of living for Jesus now that he has been saved. As for our church invitations that I mentioned last month, our video containing the gospel in Icelandic has over 3,000 views. One of our church members even mentioned that they were listening to YouTube and all of a sudden our video began playing. We are so grateful that God still has a desire to reach Iceland with the gospel.
