As 2025 zooms towards its close, I am so thankful for the opportunity that God has given to me and my family to share His Word to the nation of Iceland. God allowed us to see some great things in November. We, of course, held our regular services in English and Icelandic, in which we are seeing great growth and constant visitors. It was a year ago this month that God provided the funds through many churches to purchase our church van. Just this past Sunday the odometer read exactly 30,000 kilometers driven. We are so thankful that God has given the privilege of bringing so many people to church through this. We pick up around nineteen people on average each week, meaning that over the past year, we have been able to bring almost **one thousand** people to church! Also in November, we held our annual Thanksgiving outreach program. Each year, we encourage our church to invite one special guest to a night of good food, games, and fellowship. This year, many guests came and heard the gospel. We pray that we made a lasting impression on them that they might come back to continue learning about the wonderful gift of life that God offers. I took this picture this past Sunday of our older group of children that attend our Icelandic services. This week, due to our Thanksgiving outreach and all the other unexpected things that happened, we were unable to visit the children as we normally do each week. Due to this, we saw a dramatic decline in attendance. With nearly half of our regular attendees absent, we see the need to continue doing the simple yet necessary things of the ministry. Often these things go unnoticed, and unthanked, yet they are absolutely crucial to keeping this work in motion.



The Road Ahead

With Christmas and New Year's just around the corner, we will be holding an international concert where we will attempt to bring all areas of this ministry together for one service. Our Icelandic teen service is on Wednesday evening, while our English service is on Sunday morning; in addition, we have our Icelandic services for all ages on Sunday afternoons. Due to the varying times, many of these groups have never met, so we are holding this concert of special music in an attempt to bring all areas of this ministry under the same roof for this special time. Please pray that God would use this to His glory.
