If you have ever attended a Christian summer camp, you know how God's influence in your life becomes more powerful than normal. The removal of distractions and constant meditation on God's Word work together in ways you never truly expected. This year our summer camp was just that. With nearly thirty children in attendance, several volunteer staff members from the U.S., and many of our church members playing critical roles, we were able to host this fantastic event. Even from the very onset of the week, the spirit between children, teenagers, staffers, and everyone around was loving and kind. We focused our efforts to teach those in attendance about how God has a special life and a special plan just for you. We also taught that we should not live for ourselves like the world emphasizes so dramatically, but rather to live for something bigger than yourself. We heard from several different people, including a nurse, a fireman, a missionary, and a couple from Samaritan's Purse who shared how they were living their life in pursuit of serving others. By the end of the week, we saw EIGHT children trust Christ as their personal Savior, three making decisions to be baptized, and several teenagers making powerful decisions to attend church faithfully and to stay away from the sin this world is already trying to convince them is normal. To say, "Thank you" does not even come close to the gratitude we have for those of you who prayed and sacrificed so that we could have this camp. Every dollar was put to great use. We sing the song that one day, "It will be worth it all," which is so true, but I can truly say that this camp was worth every dollar.

The Road Ahead

We are pressing through the cleanup of the camp, encouraging those who made decisions to trust Christ, and much more. At the end of the camp, we hold a free carnival in our church building and invite all the family and friends of the campers to attend for several hours. The only cost of entrance is your contact information, which we are able to use to visit and call them. We are so excited for the future of the gospel here in Iceland. You may have heard me give the analogy that building a church in Iceland is like sowing seeds in a parking lot. Well, it looks like we are seeing some cracks in that pavement.
